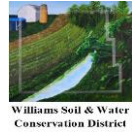

15' John Deere 1590 No-till Drill – 2023 Model

- Row markers
- 7.5" row spacing for beans, wheat, & other crops with small seed box attachment for hay seed & grasses
- Your tractor (around 90 - 100 hp) and our drill
- Rental charges for the no-till drill: \$10 per acre with a \$100 minimum - includes delivery and set up



10' Great Plains 1006NT No-till Drill

- 7.5" row spacing
- Small seed box
- Native warm season grass box
- Small grains box
- Your tractor (75 hp minimum) and our drill
- Rental charges for the no-till drill: \$10 per acre with a \$100 minimum - includes delivery and set up



NEW 15½-foot I & J Crimper Crop Roller, Trailed Model

Many conventional farmers recognize no-till farming benefits and make the move to organic farming with this step saving tool. Or they can use the Roller Crimper as part of their conventional farming program to reduce the amount of herbicide sprays.

- Folds up to 7.5 feet for transport with wheels
- Cover crop management without herbicides or tillage
- Reduced herbicide use in conventional no till farming systems
- Mulching effects and barrier attributes of cover crop are maximized
- Rolling and compressing improves the weed suppression of the cover crop
- Reduction of water evaporation from the soil
- Better incorporation of crop residue in organic farming
- Rental charges for the crimper: \$5 per acre with a \$100 minimum - includes delivery and set up

- Pulls behind tractor (not provided)
- Capable of planting trees in sod
- Rental charges: \$25.00 for the first 1,000 trees planted; \$10.00 for each additional 1,000 trees planted with a \$50.00 minimum charge
